Hello!

Thanks for your email. I attach forms for you to complete for your child to attend BSPS this coming summer. This should be returned to the above address with payment once you have definitely decided on dates. Places are limited on several dates for 2018, so a prompt response is always helpful.

Our dates are Monday 23rd July – Friday 24th August 2018, starting at 9.30am until 3.30pm, (4pm for The Big Toppers and the Junior Toppers), with extended hours and wraparound care provided for a small fee. Please provide your child with a packed lunch (no crisps, choccie, biscuits, fizzy drinks), and remember that we provide for the Tree Toppers organic juice and snacks throughout the day, so just pack a small lunch. We make sure the children drink plenty of water. The Children and the staff all enjoy lunch together.

The children are split in three groups, 3 – 7 years (Tree Toppers), 8 - 12 years (Big Toppers) and 12 – 14 (Junior Toppers).

The Tree Toppers may go out in the afternoons on scooters, to play games, butterfly searching, bird watching, & kite flying and various outdoor activities on Barnes common. Our security policy is very robust and we **never ever** leave children unattended.

The Big Toppers provides children between 8 – 12 years with some constructive and entertaining fun during the summer. Most days the children are taken somewhere different in and around London. Public transport is used as well the river boats, mini bus with an experienced driver. The big Toppers will spend most of the day offsite enjoying the many sights of London. They may also visit local attractions, parks and museums.

The Junior Toppers is new for 2018 and is an extension of the Big Toppers. Most days the children are taken somewhere different, this may be in and around London or in the home counties. Trips may include Kayaking, Indoor Rock Climbing, Trampoline Parks and various other activities, with an emphasis on stimulating the children and educating them without losing their attention.

The Maximum amount of children taken out each day for Big Toppers is 12 and 8 for the Junior Toppers. The staff ratio is generally 4:1.

Please complete the enclosed application form for each of your children who wish to attend. Once completed please send back by post or scan the application and send it via email. Please ensure payment is also sent via your bank or returned with a cheque. Spaces can not be reserved until full payment has been received.

OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES AND PLAY AREA FOR TREE TOPPERS

Outdoor play is an important part of each session, and the Barnes Summer Play School has a small area where children are involved in 'messy' activities such as playing with sand and other outdoor toys under the supervision of a member of staff.

From time to time and if the weather permits the staff of the Barnes Summer Play School may also organise short excursions on Barnes Common where the children will have more space to enjoy and to explore.

At all times, during these excursions the children will be fully supervised by staff to ensure that they are safe and cared for in all circumstances.

Children should come with suitable clothing and sensible shoes for the time of the year and be prepared for **rain or full sunshine**.

PROCEDURE FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL TREATMENT

Parents are asked to inform **Barnes Summer Play School** if a child is unable to attend due to illness. If the child has had diarrhoea, vomiting or conjunctivitis please keep the child at home for at least 48hrs after the last occurrence. **Medicines cannot be administered at school without prior written notice. This is also dependant of the case.**

- In case of Emergency, Parents/Carers will be informed immediately by a member of the Barnes Summer Play School staff.
- If necessary an ambulance will be called or if appropriate the child will be transported to hospital by car or taxi and accompanied by a member of the staff.
- Accident details to be recorded in the accident book and if necessary a report form will be forwarded to Ofsted.
- The Parent/Carer will be contacted as soon as possible and maybe whilst the child is being transported to hospital.
- **At all times the child's safety will take priority.**
- Prompt First Aid will be administration by a qualified member of the school staff for minor injuries or ailments.
