

Barnes Summer Play School

Supervision of volunteers, students and work experience individuals

Barnes Summer Play School employs **students** and on occasions **volunteers** and individuals wanting to get involved with **work experience** are invited to participate at BSPS

These team members go through a small amount of in-house training. This will include familiarising themselves with all school policies. They will attend several sessions before school commences. They will also be offered Safeguarding, Play Worker and First Aid training courses. These team members are **never left unsupervised**, but most certainly form an important part of the team and will attend all staff meetings where they are invited to express their ideas on a day to day basis. Team meetings are held every morning.

Students wishing to continue working at BSPS for a few years are encouraged to take further training courses in **Play Work** wherever possible and if necessary BSPS will fund the courses.

The safety of the children who attend BSPS is key when it comes to inviting any of the above mentioned. Therefore, none of the students, volunteers or those on work experience are unknown to the owner/manager of BSPS. DBS checks are carried out to all staff 18+. None of the above mentioned are left alone with the children.
